# 1 USING THE UPDATE MANAGER

By means of the Update Manager you can perform software updates at regular intervals. It is possible to let **ARCWAY Cockpit** search for updates automatically.

## 1.1 Updating installed Features

To check whether updates of **ARCWAY Cockpit** are available. An Internet connection is required. In the Designer Edition, the ARCWAY Update Server available on the Internet is preset as the update source. Therefore, an Internet connection (HTTP connection) is required in this case. If Internet access is only possible by using a proxy, the HTTP proxy configuration (General/Network Connections in the User Preferences dialog) must be configured correctly.

1. Click **Help » Check for Updates** in the main menu. This will contact the update repositories associated with the product's features as well as the connected cockpit servers to discover what versions of those features are available. The potential updates are presented in on the next page.

### Available Updates

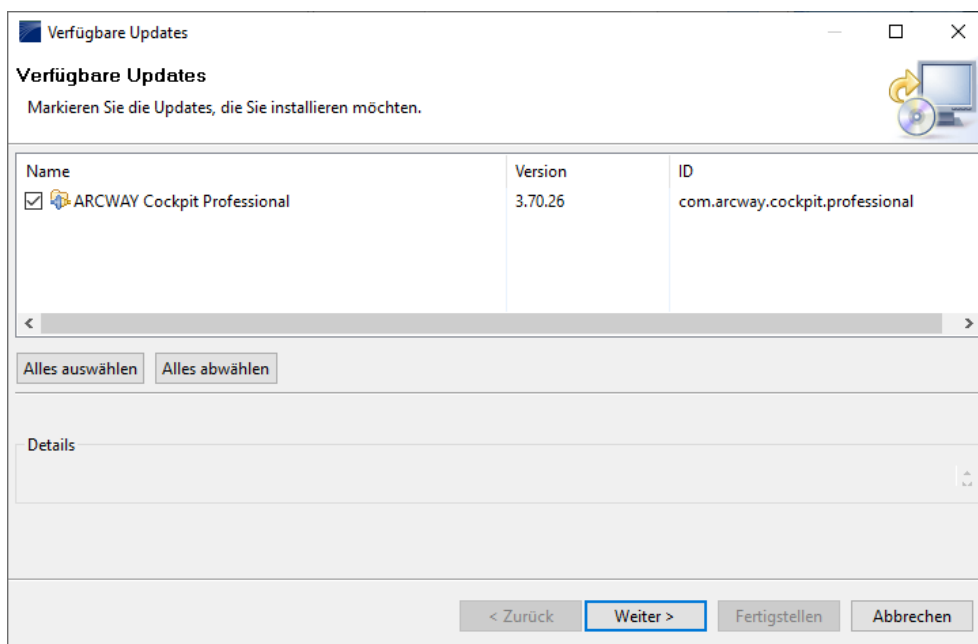


Figure 1: Available Updates

2. Select the features you want to update and click **Next**. Please note that the interaction of the different features is only possible if the versions of the different features match. Therefore, it is generally not possible to update only individual features. Instead, all offered updates must normally be selected.
3. The following confirmation dialog appears, which shows the selected updates again and informs you about possible problems after the update:

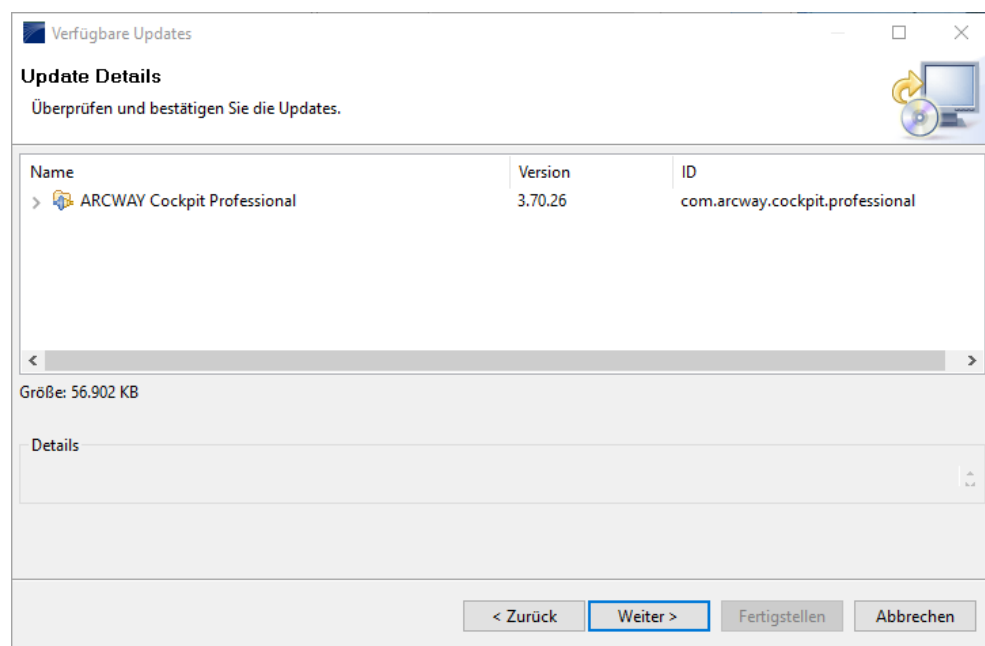


Figure 2: Update Details

4. Carefully review the license agreements for the updated features. If the terms of all these licenses are acceptable, check *I accept the terms in the license agreements*. Features with not accepted license agreements cannot be installed.

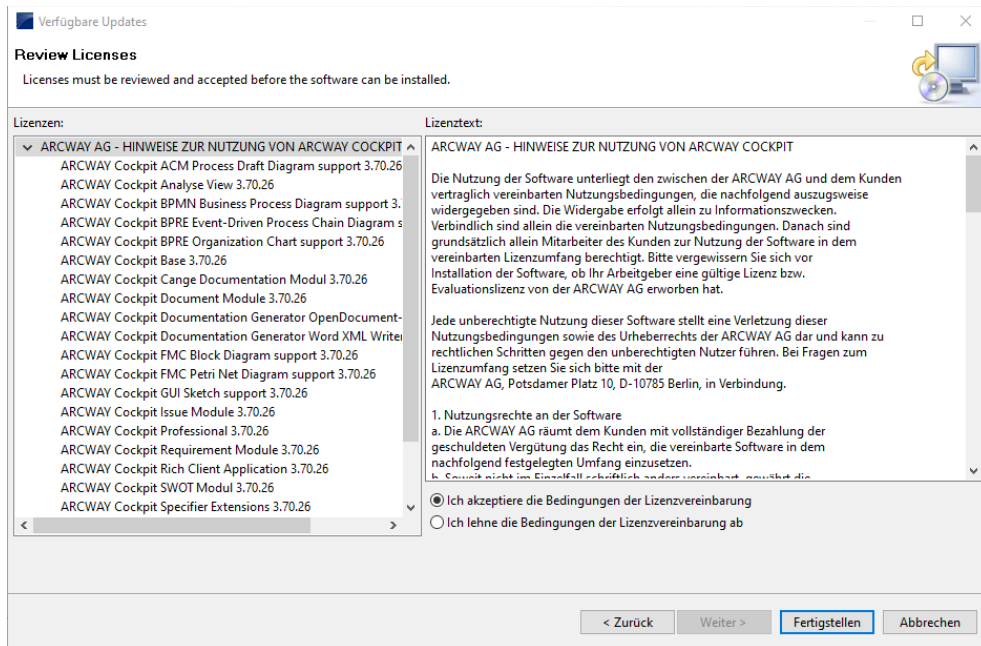


Figure 3: Review Licenses

5. Click *Finish* to allow the downloading and installing to proceed. A progress dialog will be shown:

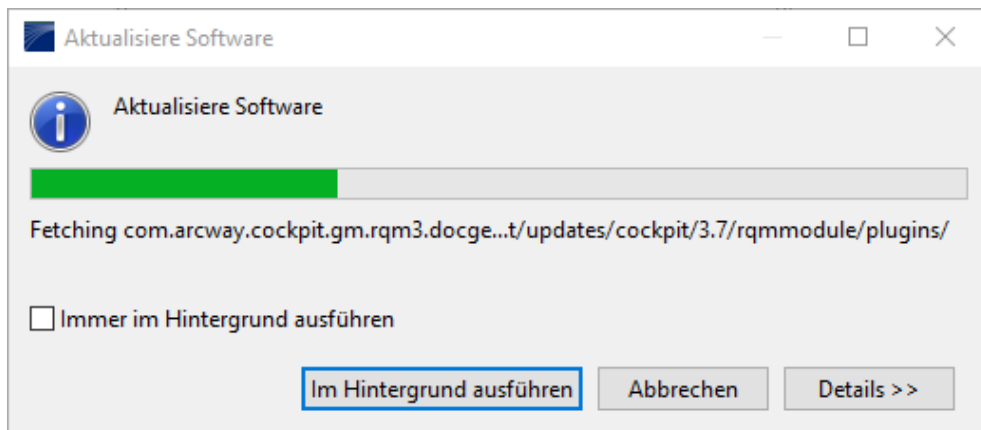


Figure 4: Updating Software

6. Feature versions can be digitally signed by the company that provides them. This makes it easier to verify that the features and plug-ins to be downloaded and installed are from an acceptable supplier.

*As there is the possibility of harmful or destructive plug-ins, you should only download features from suppliers you trust. Features which are digitally signed by ARCWAY are always trustworthy.*

Click **OK** to proceed with downloading and installing.

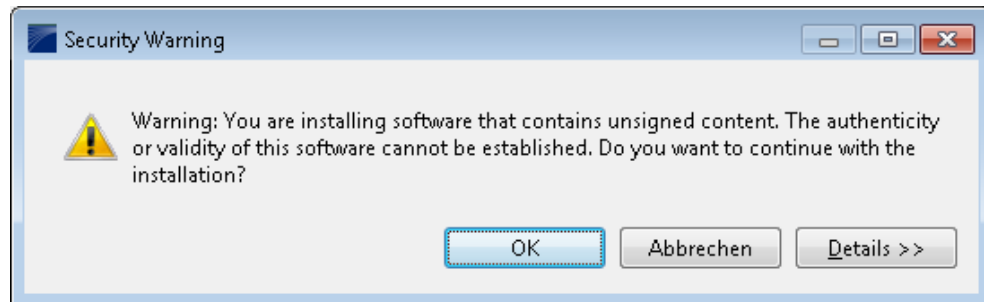


Figure 5: Security Warning

7. Once all the features and plug-ins have been downloaded successfully and their files installed, a new configuration that incorporates these features and plug-ins will be formulated. Click *Yes* when asked to exit and restart the Workbench for the changes to take effect. After restarting you can continue working with your updated version of **ARCWAY Cockpit**.
